SELF DIRECTED LEARNING OF THE STUDENTS OF GRADUATE SCHOOL OF ISLAMIC CULTURE AND HISTORY STUDY PROGRAM

Abstract. Self directed learning is one of factors which influences students' learning achievement. This study aims at finding out Self Directed Learning of the Students of Graduate School of Islamic Culture and History Study Program at learning.
